



Nonviolence: The Global Choice!

The C.W. Post Library is focusing on the **six point initiative of the UN Manifesto 2000-Peace Is in Our Hands** to celebrate and support the "International Year for the Culture of Peace" and the "Season of Nonviolence" (January 30th - April 4th, 2001). In conjunction with this event the library is planning a travelling exhibit to be shown at Post and at other selected organizations. In addition the library will incorporate student works in its online exhibit/database. The library is soliciting original materials from students - art prints, photographs, posters, essays, poetry, and slogans. The students may collaborate; for example a writer and artist may work together, if they choose. These selected entries will be integrated with library resources for the exhibit.

1. Written entries may be
 - a. an essay (1-4 pages)
 - b. poetry
 - c. slogans

Please note: written entries may include artwork if desired.

2. Art work may be
 - a. an art print (lithograph, silkscreen, computer graphics)
 - b. a reproduction of artwork - drawings, paintings, posters, cartoons, and collages
(if original cannot be given)
 - c. photographs.

Please note: All materials submitted must be created by the entrant. A good quality copy of original art work is all right to submit. Entries should be of a standard size (no smaller than 5" X 7" or larger than 14" X 17").

3. Since this is a travelling exhibit, all selected entries will become the property of the library and none will be returned. Entrants will be acknowledged in the exhibit catalogue and included in the nonviolence online exhibit.
4. Selected entries may be used in library publications if considered appropriate.
5. **Deadline for all entries is December 15, 2000.**
