Updates

Phase I Feedback: Faculty Fellows will be providing feedback to departments on Phase I reports during the month of February. Liaisons will be communicating with their respective departments after feedback sessions to ascertain what their needs are for spring.

Middle States - Assessing Learning Working Group: The 2013 Middle States reaccreditation self-study (<http://liu.edu/About/Accreditation.aspx>) is being organized around the institutional priorities of the Strategic Agenda and will be written in four chapters. The first chapter will address both institutional and educational effectiveness. Institutional Effectiveness is being chaired by Provost Gale Stevens Haynes, Esq., who has charged the Campus' Retention Task Force to develop the best strategies for responding to the other relevant standards. Under the leadership of Jeff Kane, VPAA, the Assessing Learning Working Group has been organized to address the Middle States standards that relate to the assessment of student learning (Standard 11: Educational Offerings, Standard 12: General Education, and Standard 14: Assessment of Student Learning). With the direct support of the outcomes assessment committee co-chairs at both residential campuses, the Deputy VPAA, and University Director of Assessment this group will spend the next 18 months gathering and analyzing evidence to document the university's meeting of Middle States expectations regarding educational effectiveness.
