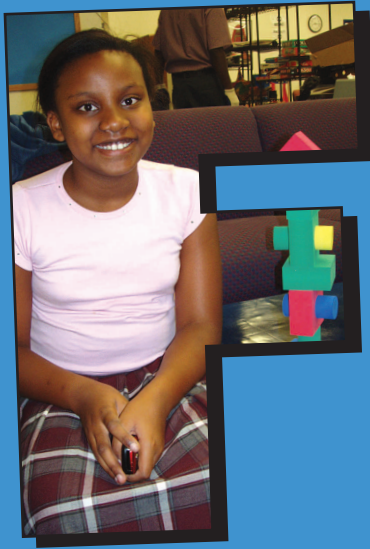

Who We Are

The Family University After School and Evening Program (FUN) offered at Long Island University's Brooklyn Campus provides after school care for the children of Brooklyn Campus students who are in the 1st-7th grades. FUN is an educational enrichment program with a creative arts focus.

When FUN Happens

In the fall and spring semesters, FUN is available four days a week. **Monday through Thursday, 3:15 p.m. - 8:30 p.m.** Children are provided with a healthy snack and with dinner.

Where FUN Happens

FUN takes place at the School of Education's Learning Center for Educators & Families (LCEF), located at 9 Hanover Place, 3rd Floor, between Fulton Street and Livingston Street. Children must be dropped off and picked up at LCEF.

Who is Eligible

Brooklyn Campus students who are presently enrolled, meet financial eligibility requirements and have children in the 1st-7th grades.

Cost and How to Apply

The cost is a sliding scale, from \$25-\$100 per family, per semester. Applications are available at the Learning Center for Educators & Families. There are 30 slots available each semester. Placement is made on a first-come, first-served basis after eligibility review, approval, payment and orientation attendance.
