Fieldwork Placements – Page Two

As of the Spring 2014 semester, all fieldwork placements for students in non-residency, initial certification programs will only be in schools where we have established relationships in Brooklyn and lower Manhattan. We will no longer accept student requests for specific school placements. Students already working in schools will continue to have their placements on the job, as long as the schools meet the fieldwork requirements.

As the certification requirements have changed effective May 2014, the SOE will be focusing on strengthening your beginning teaching practice prior to your student teaching experience. As part of our ongoing efforts to strengthen the quality of your teacher education experience, school placements for the NYS required 100 hours of fieldwork will only be in schools where we have established relationships. Faculty and administrators are coordinating with specific schools that are aware of and able to fulfill our emphasis on teaching in small groups or working one on one with Pre-K -12^{th} grade students in schools.
