

Application for membership in the **CAMPUS ACTIVITIES PROGRAM
for the **Spring 2014** semester.
[Open to Undergraduate Students Only]**

Students interested in co-curricular activities, community service, volunteer work and student leadership may consider the application for membership in the Campus Activity Program. Consideration for this program is based mainly on interest in planning and participation in student activities, on academic performance and on financial need. Students work under the direction of the Office of Student Life and Leadership Development for 15 hours each week except during exams, and are required to do other service throughout the year. Students in the program for the Spring 2014 semester are **required** to actively participate in voter registration programs, work all the Blood Drives, and attend the all-day Advocacy Day in Albany on February 11, 2014. Persons interested in being a part of this program must have a cumulative grade point average of at least a 3.0, and have completed at least two consecutive full-time, semesters (24 credits minimum) at the Brooklyn Campus. All outstanding balances should be paid, and students must file a FAFSA form. Returning students to the Brooklyn Campus must complete at least two consecutive, full-time semesters before being eligible for the grant. All CAP applicants will be required to have an interview. **All applicants (new and renewing) must call the Office to set up an appointment for the interview.** Interviews will be done by appointment only. If you meet these criteria, complete this application and submit it along with a letter of recommendation from an administrator, professor or staff member, to the Office of Student Life and Leadership Development (M-311) by **December 20, 2013**. If you are a returning student, the supervisor of your current placement must fill out an evaluation and send it to Karlene Thompson in M-311, Student Life. As an incentive for being a part of this program, students will be given **\$2500 in tuition remission per semester**. Please note that Resident Assistants, Student Government Association Executives, America Reads and College Work Study recipients, **and students involved in certain other programs may not be eligible for this program. Note also, that this program is based off a 15-hour per week work component. If you are unable to work for at least 15 hours per week, you are NOT ELIGIBLE for this program and grant.** For more information concerning this program please call (718)488-1216.
