## **Laptop and Notebook Safety Tips**

Laptops and Notebooks can be easy targets for theft. Here are some tips on how to safeguard your Laptops and Notebooks so that you will not become a victim of theft.

- 1) Password protect your Laptop or Notebook so that it is difficult to gain access.
- 2) Do not leave your Laptop or Notebook unattended for any period of time.
- 3) If you need to leave your Laptop or Notebook unattended, you should lock it up or lock it down to an immoveable object.
- 4) Consider buying a lock or tracking software for your Laptop or Notebook.
- 5) Consider purchasing Laptop or Note book insurance in case of damage or theft.
- 6) Don not leave your Laptop or Notebook visible in your vehicle while you are not in it.
- 7) If you live on campus, always be sure to lock your windows and doors before leaving your room, even for brief moments.
