It could be your "world" at LIU Post or it can be the "world" at large, also known as Planet Earth. Ultimately, we want to see works that incorporate the concept of sustainability in addition to how sustainability has shaped the good work that you do in this world.

We all contribute something to this planet. How will your project reflect that work?

**Students are allowed to choose from any of the categories below and more. Please note though that you are not required to submit a piece of work that fits the description of any of these categories. Your options are infinite. Let your imagination run wild!**

**Written word:** Submissions in this category may include essays, poems, and short stories, etc.

**Visual Art:** Submissions in this category may include paintings, drawings, photographs, dance, mixed media, graphic design and collages, etc.

**Audio Visual:** Submissions in this category may include original composition, videos and animation, etc. A video or CD for any original performance piece will be required.

**All submissions must be turned into the Office of Student Life and Leadership Development, Hillwood Commons Room 102 by no later than April 18, 2014 at 4pm. Late submissions WILL NOT be accepted!**
