#### From the WEST

L.I. Expressway to Exit 39 (Glen Cove Rd). Go North to Northern Blvd (Route 25 A). Turn Right. Go 2 miles to LIU, CW Post Campus (Tilles Center)- West Gate. Turn right onto Post Lane. Humanities Hall is South of the large building facing Northern Boulevard in the center of campus. If you cannot find parking in the lots to your left, pass the Tilles Center and park in the Southern lots. Then walk through Hillwood Commons. When you exit the building on the North side, HUMANITIES HALL will be straight ahead to the left. ROOM 119

#### From the EAST

L.I. Expressway. to Exit 41N (Rt.107). Go North on 107, bear left at fork where 106 &107 split. Turn left onto North. Blvd (Rt 25A). Go 1/8<sup>th</sup> mile to 1<sup>st</sup> light and turn left into LIU. Make immediate right onto University Dr. At 2<sup>nd</sup> stop (W. Gate), turn left onto Post Lane. Humanities Hall is South of the large building facing N. Boulevard in the center of campus. If paring spots in the lots to your left, pass the Tilles Center and park in the Southern lots. Then walk through Hillwood Commons. When you exit the building on the North side, HUMANITIES HALL will be straight ahead to the left. ROOM 119
