AWARD STATISTICS

- ▲ For 2013-14, LIU Post committed more than \$50 million of its resources in scholarships to students.
- ▲ For 2013-14, the average assistance package for students with demonstrated financial need (combining need-based grants, scholarships, loans and student employment) was \$16,000.

FIND OUT HOW TO MAKE IT AFFORDABLE.

One of LIU Post's goals is to help make a quality private education affordable for people from all backgrounds. The Student Financial Services Office is available to help students and their families through the financial aid application process, which can seem like an overwhelming task without the proper guidance.

By learning about the various sources of aid and the application process, you can make sure that you receive the most financial aid possible. Completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) prior to Feb.15 (Fall applicants) or Nov.1 (Spring applicants) will give you a better opportunity to secure your financial aid via grants and loans. Financial assistance offered after these dates is subject to availability. Students are also encouraged to consult with their employers to inquire if they offer tuition reimbursement programs.

ADDITIONAL FINANCING OPTIONS

LIU payment plans allow you to spread any remaining balance due, after all financial aid has been applied, across monthly installments for a small fee of \$35 per term. With this option, you have the freedom to use your money to earn interest or investment income while you pay in small installments over the year. A variety of payment methods are accepted, including personal checks, money orders, online payments, credit cards and ACH automated payments from your checking account.

FIND OUT HOW TO GET THERE.

SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION TO LIU POST

- ▲ Apply online at liu.edu/post/apply or contact the Admissions Office at 516-299-2900.
- ▲ Pay the \$50 application fee securely online or by check.

ACTIVATE YOUR ACCOUNT

- ▲ Go to **my.liu.edu** and click the "Activate My Account" button at the top right of the screen. You can track the status of your application on **MyLIU**.
- ▲ Enter your Social Security Number or student ID number, your date of birth and the displayed security code to activate your **MyLIU** account.
- ▲ For assistance with activating and using your account, visit the Center for Student Information at csi.liu.edu.

COMPLETE YOUR FAFSA

- ▲ Apply online at fafsa.ed.gov using our Federal school code of **002751**. Contact the Student Financial Services Office at 516-299-2323 or post-sfs@liu.edu for assistance with completing your FAFSA.
- ▲ New and continuing students must submit a FAFSA each year by Feb.15 or your financial aid package may be reduced or cancelled, based on the availability of funds.

RECEIVE YOUR ACCEPTANCE LETTER AND NOTIFICATION OF FINANCIAL AWARDS

- ▲ Your financial aid award letter will disclose your estimated cost of attendance, the total amount of grants, scholarships and loans you are eligible to receive and expected family contributions as calculated by the federal government from information included in your FAFSA.
- ▲ Financial awards can also be viewed online. (Loans must be accepted or declined using your **MyLIU** account.)

SECURE YOUR SEAT

▲ Make a \$200 tuition deposit online using your **MyLIU** account. Deposit waivers are available to qualifying students. You can also mail a check payable to Long Island University.

REGISTER FOR CLASSES

- ▲ Make an appointment to meet with your graduate adviser to register for classes.
- ▲ You may also register for classes by attending an Enrollment Services Day. Visit **liu.edu/post/yes** for dates and times.

CLEAR YOUR BILL

- ▲ You must make acceptable payment arrangements with the Student Financial Services Office prior to the start of classes to remain in good financial standing. This includes: payment in full; approved financial aid covering all charges; participation in a university payment plan; or participation in a third-party payment agreement.
- ▲ If you need assistance, please make an appointment with a financial counselor by calling 516-299-2323.

Graduate Assistantships

Graduate assistantships are available on a limited basis and are awarded as remuneration for employment in an LIU Post department. The student will have teaching responsibilities and/or direct assignments working with undergraduate students. Graduate assistants receive tuition credit assistance plus a stipend. 


FEDERAL LOAN PROGRAMS

WILLIAM D. FORD FEDERAL DIRECT LOAN PROGRAM

The Direct Loan Program is the best financing option for a graduate student and should be considered before any private educational loan options. Graduate students can borrow up to \$20,500 per year in unsubsidized direct loans, depending on financial need, to finance the cost of your education. This loan has a fixed interest rate of 6.8 percent.

The Direct PLUS Loan is a creditworthy loan for graduate students who have borrowed the maximum amount of Direct Loan assistance. PLUS loans are available to qualifying students, depending on financial need, and have a fixed interest rate of 6.41 percent.



PRIVATE EDUCATIONAL LOAN PROGRAMS

A variety of lending institutions offer private educational loans to prospective students. These loans should only be considered after exhausting eligibility in the Federal Direct Student Loan program. Students and families will need to conduct research to find the best private educational loan to suit their needs (e.g., determining interest rates, co-signer requirements, repayment options and whether the loan may be sold to another provider). Students must apply directly with the lender.

Once approved for a private loan, LIU Post will review the loan for school certification. This process includes confirming enrollment and verifying eligibility for the type of loan and amount requested. Loan funds are disbursed in accordance with the terms of the loan once all necessary paperwork has been completed. The complete process may take up to 28 business days.
