COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Sociology of Development 3 undergraduate credits

This course will analyze the current development issues in Costa Rica. Students will study the evolution of economic, social, political, environmental, gender and poverty concerns. Two extended field trips to Sarapiqui and the Caribbean coast and the Guanacaste province are included. Other day trips to a coffee plantation, Poas Volcano, Ministry of Planning, Mlnistry of Women and Gender Issues, and Intel Plant are scheduled. These field experiences will help the student create a proposal on how best to address/solve specific development problems.

Spanish Language

3 undergraduate credits

Spanish language coursework provides students with an immersion experience. Through intensive classroom work and field experiences, students immerse themselves in the language and the culture of Costa Rica. Offered at beginner, intermediate and advanced levels; no previous knowledge of Spanish language is required.

ESTIMATED PROGRAM COST

Tuition (6 credits) - \$5,844 (\$974 per credit)
Room & Board/Center Fee - \$1,260
University Fee - \$360
International Fee - \$180
Total Charges - \$7,644

Please budget approximately \$1,000* for flight and other personal expenses.

Important: If you are awarded the DeWitt Wallace Scholarship, you will be responsible for the remainder of the program costs, which includes the LIU Bill (\$944*) in addition to the flight and personal expenses (\$1,000*) for a total of approximately \$1,944.

*Estimated Costs - an exact figure will not be determined until all travel arrangements have been confirmed.

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

A \$6,700 scholarship is available to all LaGuardia Community College, Kingsborough Community College, Queensborough Community College, and LIU Brooklyn students who meet eligibility requirements. The total cost of the entire program, including tuition, room/board, airfare, books, field trips and spending money is approximately \$8,644. The scholarship will cover approximately \$0% of the costs, and students should expect to contribute approximately \$1,944. This figure is approximate due to flight availability and pricing as well as each individual student's personal needs.

SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 3.0 GPA on 4.0 scale
- A minimum of 30 completed credits
- Average annual family income less than \$75,000
- Ability to raise balance of the program cost (approx. \$1,944) not covered by the scholarship
