

CAEP Annual Reporting Measures

CAEP (Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation) has the following eight annual reporting measures, which are used to provide information to the public on program outcome and program impact.

1. Impact on P-12 learning and development:

LIU Riverhead is in the process of collecting case study data about its program completer's impact on P-12 learning and development.

2. Indicators of teaching effectiveness:

3. Satisfaction of employers and employment milestones

4. Satisfaction of completers

Upon completion of clinical practice, our teacher candidates are required to complete a survey assessing how well they feel their course of study at LIU Riverhead has prepared them for their future career as a teacher.

Alumni Surveys

An alumni survey is distributed annually to teacher education graduates to measure their satisfaction of the teacher preparation program and to measure how well prepared they feel for their assigned responsibilities working with P-12 students.

6. Ability of completers to meet licensing requirements and additional state requirements:

In 2016-2017 LIU Riverhead recommended 77% of its completers for certification.

At the time of this report, of the students who were recommended for initial certification, 57% were certified by New York State. Of the students who were recommended for advanced certification, 31% were certified.
