



LIU Campus Climate Survey

2021 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Long Island University administered a Campus Climate Survey on Sexual Misconduct to all enrolled undergraduate and graduate students from April 20, 2021 to May 18, 2021. A link to the survey itself was emailed on April 20, 2021. Students also received three email reminders, each containing the survey link.

Of the undergraduate and graduate student body surveyed, 695 (5%) responded to the survey. All responses were voluntary and anonymous. The survey was conducted online via Campus Labs as a third-party platform. The survey determined student awareness of reporting and university processes for sexual harassment, sexual violence and related crimes. The results indicated that students are generally aware of policies, procedures, resources and roles, including the role of the Title IX coordinator. Students were also generally aware of the New York definition of affirmative consent, and the difference between the university disciplinary system and penal laws.

LIU uses the survey results as part of its ongoing efforts to provide students with information and support regarding campus sexual misconduct.
