

Long Island University Non-Discrimination Policy

All members of the LIU community are expected to treat one another with respect and with equality, without regard to one's race, color, sex, marital status, age, sexual orientation, ethnic or national origin, religion or creed, physical or mental disability or status as a veteran.

This policy calls upon us to be fair in all matters, academic and non-academic. Discrimination (including sexual harassment, which is a form of discrimination based on one's sex) will not be tolerated at LIU. If substantiated, an allegation of discrimination may lead to disciplinary action up to - and including - expulsion from the University.
