STATEMENT OF POLICY

SUNY Student Conduct Institute

The **SUNY Student Conduct Institute (SUNYSCI)** provides in-depth live and digital training to student conduct officials, hearing officers, Title IX officials and other college personnel in due process, trauma-informed investigations, and adjudications, questioning and weighing of evidence, and other crucial best practices in the investigation and conduct process that comply with relevant case law, Title IX guidance, the Clery Act, and New York Education Law 129-B.

Member institutions utilize the SUNY Conduct Institute to provide their staff with training “on how to fairly and equitably investigate and adjudicate conduct violations and disclosures.” These training include “due process, trauma-informed investigations and adjudications, questioning and weighing of evidence, and other crucial best practices in the investigation and conduct process that comply with case law, Title IX, the Clery Act, and other relevant federal and state laws.”
