



## FACILITIES OPERATIONS UMBRELLA OSHA POLICY

### PURPOSE

To apply Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) Standards that ascribes generic and specific umbrella policy guidelines for all applicable Facilities Operational procedures, requirements, rules and regulations.

### STATEMENT OF POLICY

The University's Facilities Service Operations adopts OSHA Standard guidelines and baselines for Facilities Operations. These OSHA Standards comprise the following:

- Indoor Air Quality – Code of Federal Regulation (CFR) – 1910.94;
- Fire Protection - Code of Federal Regulation (CFR) - 1910.150;
- Eyewash Stations & Non-Mandatory First Kits - Code of Federal Regulation (CFR) 1910.151;
- Mandatory First Aid Kits - Code of Federal Regulation (CFR) - 1910.266 Appendix A;
- Fire Extinguishers - Code of Federal Regulation (CFR) - 1910.157;
- Asbestos Exposure & Asbestos Work - Code of Federal Regulation (CFR) - 1910.1001 & 1910.1101;
- Bloodborne Pathogens - Code of Federal Regulation (CFR) - 1910.1030;
- Hazard Communications, Hazard Materials Delivery & Disposal of Laboratory Chemicals Code of Federal Regulation (CFR) - 1910.1450;
- Motor Vehicle Operating - Code of Federal Regulation (CFR) - 1926.601.

The Facilities Services Operations team, specifically, the Environmental Health and Safety Manager (ESHM) has overall responsibility ensuring that OSHA standards are included in contract language documentation and other relevant facilities standard operating procedures.
