FIREARMS POLICY

PURPOSE

This policy ensure the University's compliance with [Article 265 of the NYS Penal Law](#).

STATEMENT OF POLICY

Long Island University strictly prohibits the possession of firearms on all campuses. Other than police officers or military personnel on active duty, no person, including a licensee, may possess firearms anywhere on campus, whether in a building or on the grounds, without the prior written permission of the campus Director of Public Safety. The possession of dangerous weapons on any University owned or controlled site is also strictly prohibited.

Violators of this policy will be subject to immediate disciplinary action and potential criminal prosecution.

DEFINITIONS

The terms 'firearm' and 'dangerous weapons' include, by way of example only, any pistol, revolver, incendiary bomb, switchblade, dagger or bludgeon, as well as harmless instruments designed to look like weapons.
