As you know, on March 16, 2020, following spring break, all University courses will move to online instruction for the remainder of the semester.

LIU residence halls and residential dining facilities are remaining open at this time and we are not requesting students to move out. However, we recognize that some students may want to return home prior to the end of the semester or not return to campus from spring break.

**Please note the following updates related to residential students:**

- All University offices will remain open for business operations until further notice.

- Fitness Center and athletic facilities will be closed until further notice.
- No day or overnight guests will be permitted in the residence halls, including LIU commuter students.
- Room Selection for fall 2020 will continue as planned. LIU Promise will communicate via email.
- Student organization and large-scale student-run events have been suspended for the remainder of the semester.
