Geoffrey Cowan is a University Professor at the University of Southern California where he holds the Annenberg Family Chair in Communication Leadership and serves as Director of the Annenberg Center on Communication Leadership and Policy. A former Dean of the USC Annenberg School and former Director of the Voice of America, Cowan is a Fellow of the American Academy of Arts & Sciences, the Walter Lippmann Fellow of the Academy of Political & Social Science,

and a Trustee of the Theodore Roosevelt Association. In addition to *Let the People Rule: Theodore Roosevelt and the Birth of the Presidential Primary*, his publications include *The People v. Clarence Darrow: The Bribery Trial of America's Greatest Lawyer* and (with the late Leroy Aarons), *Top Secret: The Battle for the Pentagon Papers*.

A graduate of Harvard College and Yale Law School, Cowan is married to Aileen Adams. They have two children, Gabriel Cowan and Mandy Wolf, and four grandchildren.
