I hope that your spring semester is progressing successfully. The past year has challenged us in many ways and we know that the ongoing pandemic continues to cause unprecedented and unexpected hardships—many of which have put a financial strain on you and your families.

Long Island University, in accordance with the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) will begin distributing over \$3.5 million to students in need of emergency assistance. These grants are intended to help support impacted students in overcoming any setbacks encountered in pursuing their LIU degree. All “cost of attendance” expenses as defined in the Higher Education Act are eligible for consideration – including tuition and fees if you consent. Title IV eligible students at the undergraduate and graduate levels may apply for these grants.
