

Dear Students,

As you know all University courses are now being facilitated through online instruction for the remainder of the semester. As you begin classes online, I would like to share some information with you. In order to slow the spread of COVID-19 and ensure the safety of our community, we have implemented several precautionary measures at our residential campuses. The campuses will remain open for resident students only as an attempt to limit physical contact.

Please note the following guidelines relating to University students:

- Access to campus is centralized and students will be asked display their LIU ID. Post campus resident students should use the West Gate. Brooklyn campus resident students should use the main entrance at the Metcalfe Building.
- Student support services will remain open and available in a mobile format.
- Residence Halls will remain open. Residential students may remain in their residence hall, but have the option to continue their studies remotely from home. Students who wish to leave campus for the semester should complete the [Early Residential Check-out Form](#).
- Residential Dining Facilities will remain open for resident students in a grab-and-go format. At Post, Hillwood Café remains open at this time. At Brooklyn, Freshens and Peets Coffee remain open at this time.
- The Library will be open for resident students weekdays from 9 a.m. – 5 p.m. for borrowing books and reference.
- All athletic facilities and the fitness center will remain closed in accordance with NCAA and Northeast Conference best practices.
- The University Bookstore will be open Monday thru Thursday from 10 a.m. – 4 p.m. and Fridays from 10 a.m. – 2 p.m.


