Pharmacy College Admission Test (PCAT)

Send PCAT scores to PharmCAS (code 104). March 1, 2018 is the latest test accepted for Fall 2017 admissions. Scores from 2014 and earlier will not be accepted.

PharmCAS Application

Complete the PharmCAS application by May 1, 2018. The application and instructions are available at www.pharmcas.org. We encourage applicants to apply early but we will accept all applications submitted on or before May 1, 2018.

Send official transcripts from each college attended and at least three letters of recommendation to PharmCAS.

Frequently check your application status through PharmCAS to track the status of transcripts, recommendations, and PCAT scores to make sure they were received. Contact PharmCAS regarding any materials not received.

As you complete pre-requisite courses please update your PharmCAS electronic transcript during the Academic Update open window period.
